ADR: what the shipper must provide

Everything we need as the carrier to be allowed to drive an ADR container, in one place. So the trip can start right away.

For ADR container transport, the carrier needs complete and correct data. If anything is missing, the trip cannot start. This checklist sets out what you, as the shipper, provide.

SUBSTANCE DATA

- ☐ UN number of the substance.
- ☐ The correct proper shipping name.
- ☐ Hazard class and packing group.
- ☐ Number and type of packages.

DOCUMENTS

- ☐ Transport document (ADR 5.4.1) with UN number, proper shipping name, class/label, packing group and tunnel restriction code, in that order.
- ☐ Total quantity per UN number, plus the name and address of the consignor and consignee, on the transport document.
- ☐ Safety data sheet (SDS): useful context for the driver, not itself an ADR-required document.
- ☐ For sea export: container/vehicle packing certificate (ADR 5.4.2), signed by whoever packs the container.
- ☐ Any permits or exemptions.

PACKAGING AND LOADING

- ☐ ADR-approved packaging and labeling.
- ☐ Correct marking and hazard labels on the container.
- ☐ Load correctly and demonstrably secured in the container.
- ☐ Clean, leak-free packaging.
